Our investment strategy is based on academic research, not Wall Street predictions.

At Resource Consulting Group, we don't subscribe to trendy Wall Street newsletters. We don't make decisions based on daily market reports or information promoted by banks, insurance companies or pension funds. We tune out media "experts" who claim to predict the future, because we've found such predictions to be unreliable. Instead, we put our trust in academic standards established from over a century of investment research.

Nobel Prize-winning thinkers drive our investment philosophy.

The financial professionals at RCG are strong advocates of the Modern Portfolio Theory of investing, which is based on data from Nobel Prize-winning economists and professors from leading institutions such as the University of Chicago, Dartmouth, Harvard, Stanford, Yale and MIT.

This theory isn't speculative; it's grounded in historical pricing data gathered since the 1920s and decades of research indicating that portfolio performance is primarily the result of asset allocation.

We practice what we preach.

Although once scorned by Wall Street, Modern Portfolio Theory has become increasingly impossible to refute. RCG's philosophy is driven by this academic approach.

Why is a financial second opinion important?

OUR PHILOSOPHY



The most relevant investment objective is to maximize the probability that your future financial objectives will be met. Improving the odds a little every year creates a high probability of success in the long run.

RCG's "Seven Investment Fundamentals" will help you avoid the dangers of market timing, stock picking, high costs and ad-hoc investment decisions – enabling you to take advantage of opportunities provided by efficient capital markets and providing an academic-based, systematic approach to reaching your financial goals.

- 1. Maintain an appropriate allocation to equities. Your allocation to equities (stocks) is the single strongest determinant of returns over long periods of time.
- 2. Stay fully invested. Market timing adds uncertainty, reduces efficiency and increases taxes and costs, all of which threaten your financial objectives.
- 3. Keep costs down. Lower costs improve long-term results geometrically. We believe the total annual portfolio costs should be no more than 1%.
- 4. Use only short-term bonds. Short-term bonds offer less risk than intermediate or long-term bonds. The risk exposure from long-term bonds is disproportionate to the small increase in return.
- 5. Include small-cap stocks. On average, small-cap stocks produce higher returns than large-cap stocks over time.
- 6. Include value stocks. On average, value stocks produce higher returns than growth stocks over time.
- 7. Have broad diversification. No single investment strategy works all the time. Increase returns and reduce risk through broad diversification applied consistently over long periods of time.

TRANSPARENCY

At RCG, we are compensated solely by the fees paid to us by our clients and receive no other compensation from any other source.

Investment Advisory Fees

The investment advisor fee is based on the fee schedule below, subject to a minimum annual investment advisory fee of \$9,000. The minimum is waived, however, for the first six months of a financial planning engagement.

Portion of assets up to \$1,000,000	0.90%
Portion of assets between \$1,000,000 and \$10,000,000	0.50%
Portion of assets in excess of \$10,000,000	0.25%

Example

The annual fee calculation for \$3,000,000 of assets under management would be:

Fees as a percentage of assets	
Total fees	\$19,000
Next \$2,000,000 x .005	\$10,000
First \$1,000,000 x .009	\$9,000

Financial planning fees

The initial financial planning fee is based on the complexity of your situation and will be determined in advance of the engagement. Annual financial plan update fees are typically 40% of the initial financial planning fee. The average fee for a financial plan can range between \$5,000 and \$12,000.
